**Family Service opens new location in Uvalde**

**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE – UVALDE, Texas (June 16, 2022)** – Family Service recognizes the increased need for available family and individual counseling, parenting education, youth prevention education, and other human services resources in the Uvalde area. To meet this increased need, the Uvalde Walmart has offered their vacant clinic space to Family Service, and the company has also provided a \$250,000 grant supporting comprehensive mental health services for the Uvalde community. The provided clinic space, is located at 3100 E Main St in the Uvalde Walmart building. Family Service, which is deeply embedded in the Uvalde community, has provided mental health and other support to the community since 2000 and will continue to provide those services.

All individuals and families in Uvalde and the surrounding area who wish to receive crisis support, mental health services or other human service's needs, can come to the new location and enter through the door outside of the Home and Pharmacy entrance.
